WHAT WE OFFER

The Memoriam Pathway provides an avenue for your client to remember their loved one through the very personal medium of body art. After you, as the Funeral Home Representative, upload a demographic intake form, a signed photography consent form and photographs of the deceased's tattoo, your client will describe their vision to memorialize the body art to our talented artists, who will then create an exact replica in another medium or make enhancements that will honor and memorialize their loved one.

HOW IT WORKS

Go to the Top Ribbon and enter the Funeral Home Portal.



Step 1

Download files and review instructions.



Step 2

Complete the required Intake Form and Photography Consent Form.



Step 3

Take photographs per Photography Instructions.



Step 4

Upload completed Intake Form, Photography Consent Form and photographs to the Upload Form.

COLLECT YOUR FEE

We recommend that you charge between \$50 and \$100 for your service fee based on what is customary for your locale.

FAQ TO CONSIDER

Q: My client authorized photographs to be sent to Tattoo Memorials and now is asking some specifics about the order they placed. What do I do?

A: Advise your client to contact us directly through the Contact Page on our website (www.tattoomemorials.com) for a prompt response. Once Tattoo Memorials receives the photos and documents, the Funeral Home Representative has no further responsibilities for order completion.

Q: I have reservations that I can obtain satisfactory photographs of the desired tattoo due to the condition of the deceased's body (positioning, discoloration, etc.). What should I do?

A: Consult with the Authorized Representative of the deceased about the limitations. If they wish to proceed, inform Tattoo Memorials of these limitations on the Intake Form. If issues arise during the photography session, provide the limitations on the Intake Form.
